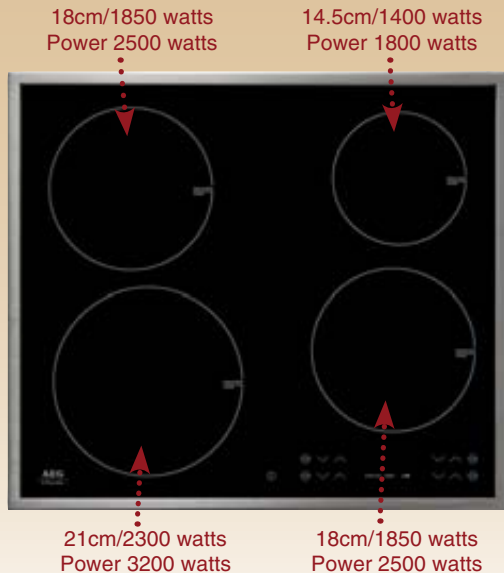
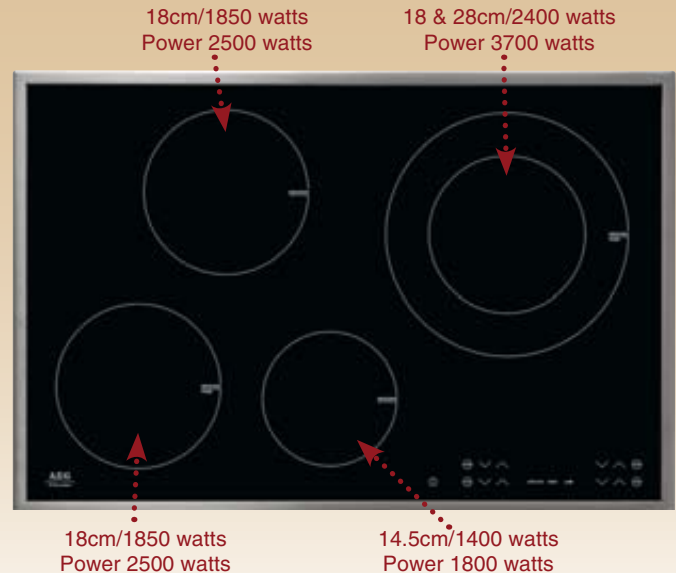


INDUCTION COOKTOPS
